II. Discussion and possible action regarding Policy #5132.1(a) Uniform Dress Code Policy and Regulation-

#### DISCUSSION:

Ms. DiGiorgi said this discussion is due to a concerned parent who spoke about the uniform policy at the last Regular Board Meeting. She said the parent is against the uniform policy and sees it as a negative rule for the students. She said according to the parent, there is no known advantage to the policy. She added along with the question, there are also updates to the wording of the dress code policy as it stands. Ms. DiGiorgi asked the members to start by looking at the gender specific wording and notice where it specifies clothing for boys and girls. Ms. DiGiorgi said this would need to be changed to "student" in order for it to be gender neutral. She gave an example of skirts or jumper skirts referring specifically to girls would be removed and the word "students" will be added.

Ms. DeLibero asked if athletes are allowed to wear their team jersey on game day. It was answered that yes, they are allowed. Ms. DeGiorgi said they will now discuss the concerns of the parent. Mr. Nimons asked what the concerns are. Ms. DiGiorgi said the parent asked for the reason uniforms are forced to be worn, what value they provide, and the fact that there are no known benefit for students to wear them. Mr. Nimons reminded Ms. DiGiorgi that he emailed her several pieces of information from his research and it showed there are many districts who are starting to wear uniforms. Ms. DiGiorgi said in her opinion, the policy is very lenient. She added it is written in the policy that any student having financial burden can submit a request with a statement of financial need and no student will be denied assistance. She said the uniform puts students on a level playing field which eliminates competition of brand labels. She said the uniform is neat and looks clean. Ms. DiGiorgi said students are there for the purpose of learning; it is not for fashion. Ms. DeLibero added when her sons were in school she felt the uniform was an asset. She said there was no competition with clothing, and the ease of not having to worry about what to wear was gone and it looked very good.
