JOINT STATEMENT OF MAYOR DAVID CASSETTI AND SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS DR. CAROL MERLONE

We are pleased to recommend a settlement of the pending lawsuit between the Ansonia Board of Education and the City of Ansonia, and a proposed resolution of the matter before the State Board of Education.

The proposed settlement is the result of two days of mediation before Retired Judge Robert L. Holzberg of the law firm Pullman & Comley, during which the parties and their counsel discussed and resolved the issues arising out of the litigation between the parties.

The proposed settlement is subject to the approval of the Ansonia Board of Aldermen and the Ansonia Board of Education. We are recommending that both Boards approve this settlement. It provides the following:

- -- The Board of Aldermen will appropriate to the Board of Education an additional \$850,000 for FY 2018-19.
- -- The minimum budget requirement for the Board of Education will be increased by \$800,000.
- -- The Board of Education will sign a letter of authorization with the City's insurance broker allowing it to analyze claims information for the purpose of evaluating insurance costs and options for the future.
- -- The Board of Education will provide additional budgetary and financial information as agreed to by the parties.
- -- The parties will work together to identify and implement a shared, modern financial platform to replace the current software.

The parties believe that this agreement is in the best interests of the Board of Education, the City of Ansonia and its citizens. We hope that this is a significant first step in establishing a positive working relationship between the parties, and greater transparency in City's and Board of Education budgeting process.
