Naugatuck Valley Medical Scholarship Fund	1/15/2021	<a href="#">Online Application</a>		To be eligible applicants must have a GPA of 3.5 or higher based on a 4.0 grade scale, with an ACT Score of 26 in English, Math, Science and Reading or SAT score of 1200 or higher. Applicants must undertake a medically-oriented or medical science-oriented program at an accredited institution of higher learning and be a resident of Ansonia, Derby, Seymour, Shelton, Oxford, or Beacon Falls.
Big Y Scholarship	2/1/2021	<a href="#">Online Application</a>	Varies	Big Y customers and their dependents and Big Y employees and their dependents are eligible. The student's permanent residence must be located in Mass or CT, unless you are an employee. Prior Big Y scholarship awarded recipients are not eligible to reapply. Online Application ONLY. Connecticut SPJ Scholarship	3/1/2021	<a href="#">Online Application</a>	Yearly 1 \$2,500 1 \$1,500 2 \$1,000	CT SPJ Scholarship requires the student be entering junior/senior year in the Fall of 2020, Declare a major in journalism, broadcasting, communications or related field, have journalistic experience with media organizations and maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5.

Roberta B. Willis Scholarship	3/1/2021	<a href="#">Online Application</a>	\$5,250 (4-year college) \$4,650 (2-year college)	To be eligible for the Roberta B. Willis Scholarship you must be a CT resident who attends a CT public or non-profit private college. Recipient must have a federal Expected Family Contribution (EFC) within the allowable range, rank in the top 20 percent of their graduating class and a minimum SAT score of 1210 or ACT score of 27.
Minority Nursing and Allied Health Scholarship	3/1/2021	<a href="#">Online Application</a>	Five four-year scholarships (\$2,000 per year)	Must be graduating from Ansonia High School, self-identify as Black, Asian, Hispanic, or Native American, have a minimum 2.5 GPA and planning to enroll in full-time study leading to a degree in Nursing or Allied Health (Registered Nurse, Pharmacy, Respiratory Therapy, Medical Technology, X-ray Technology, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, or Nuclear Medicine Technology) for the entire upcoming academic year.
Ron Brown Scholarships Program	3/3/2021	<a href="#">Online Application</a>	\$40,000 (\$10,000 per year for 4 years toward educational expenses)	Be a US Citizen or permanent resident in the US, Recipients are young African Americans of outstanding promise who demonstrate academic achievement, leadership ability & participate in community service activities.
Washington Crossing Foundation Scholarship	4/1/2021	<a href="#">Online Application</a>	\$5,000 (39 Awards)	Competition open to all high school senior who are U.S. citizens and are planning careers of service to the United States in local, state, or federal government.
The Lud & Marie Hoffman Scholarship	4/15/2021	<a href="#">Online Application</a>	\$5,000 renewable	to a CT resident, graduating high school in the spring of 2021 or a student currently enrolled at the college level majoring in the field of Horticulture. The applicant must be accepted into a course of study beneficial to the Horticultural industry (Ornamental Horticulture, Landscape Design, Nursery Management or Greenhouse Management).

They will be considered on their enthusiasm, diligence, aspirations, and potential as a valued member of the horticultural field. If you have a love of plants and are interested in going into the nursery/horticulture field and this describes you, we urge you to apply for the merit based scholarship.

Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Pursuing a Bachelor's Degree as a full-time student. Be a US Citizen or non-citizen who has a current lawful presence in the US & a work permit.
NEEBC Scholarship Program	4/1/2021	<a href="#">Online Application</a>	up to \$5,000 renewable	be a full-time or part-time college student (undergraduate or graduate) studying in an accredited academic program leading to a degree; residing either in New England, or enrolled in a college in New England. Considerations will be given to academic achievement, financial need, and the student's intent to study landscape architecture. Must maintain no lower than a 3.0 GPA.
