Dear Parents and Guardians:

Late this afternoon, we were notified about an individual who tested positive for COVID-19, which could possibly affect the Ansonia High School Girls' Basketball team. While we conduct contact tracing, we are POSTPONING tonight's NVL quarterfinal playoff game vs. Seymour High. We will provide a further update as soon as contact tracing is completed.

While we cannot share the full details for privacy reasons, we can inform you that the adults and students impacted are being informed and will be quarantined for 14 days.

Ansonia Public Schools continues to work closely with the Naugatuck Valley Health District to perform contact tracing and quarantine close contacts to prevent the spread of the virus. Quarantining as a result of close contact tracing is not an indication that someone has contracted the virus; it is simply a prudent and precautionary step.

We will keep you up-to-date on any further developments as they happen. We will also continue to follow all recommended safety protocols. Finally, please remain Ansonia Strong as we all face this national health crisis together.
